Nevada Women’s Fund is a 42-year-old nonprofit dedicated to empowering women through education and career advancement with the majority of our funding being directed toward our renowned scholarship program, which helps women pursue higher education through college, university or trade school.

Our mission is to remove barriers to education and career growth, creating professional opportunities that strengthen our communities. Since our founding, we have awarded over \$10 million in scholarships and other support to women across Northern Nevada, including rural areas—all made possible through the generosity of local donors.

What began in 1983 with two \$500 scholarships has grown into a program awarding over \$500,000 annually. Over the years, we have tracked the impact of these scholarships, gathering data on the women served, their educational paths, and career achievements. Today, our scholarship recipients contribute across diverse fields, including medicine, healthcare, business, government, education, engineering, science, entrepreneurship, and beyond.

## Awarded in Donors Name & Direction

Your input will ensure that the scholarship aligns with your company or organization's values and objectives, while also addressing critical needs within our community.



## Application/Selection Process

Nevada Women's Fund Allocations Committee is composed of 17 dedicated members including Nevada Women's Fund Board representatives and esteemed community members, who meticulously review and evaluate each eligible application received. After careful consideration, the highest-scoring applicants are thoughtfully matched with the most suitable scholarship donor(s). Scholarships ranging from \$2,000 to \$5,000 are awarded each Spring.



## Communication, Monitoring, Evaluation

Donors are extended the opportunity to personally meet their individual scholarship recipient(s), to hear firsthand the inspiring stories of the remarkable women whose lives have been positively impacted by their generosity. Nevada Women's Fund actively collects data from both current and past scholarship recipients to assess programmatic success and ensure donor satisfaction.

# Two Funding Options



## Annual Scholarship

Funded annually prior to March 1st and awarded each April

Scholarships range from \$2,000 - \$5,000 with an average of \$3,600

## Endowed Scholarship

Gradually build your endowment to the fundable amount within a span of five years, with flexibility to add additional funds at any given time.

4.5% of the endowments value is withdrawn and distributed in scholarships each spring in perpetuity.

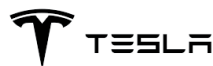
