About Us

Nevada Women's Fund (NWF) is a 40-year non-profit organization founded to empower women through education and career advancement opportunities. Although NWF awards grants to organizations and campaigns that support the education and advancement of women and families, the majority of our funding is allocated to our wellknown education scholarship program, which provides financial support for women seeking to achieve higher education.

The vision of NWF is to identify and alleviate barriers to education and career advancement for Nevada women, empowering professional opportunities, and ultimately strengthening the community in which Nevadans live and raises their families. Since inception, NWF has raised and awarded nearly \$10 million in education scholarships and grants to organizations that support, educate and empower women in the Northern Nevada region, including northern rural areas. All funds are raised from local donors.

Starting with \$500 per year in scholarship distributions in 1983, we are proud to share that in the 2024 award cycle we have grown to distribute more than \$500,000 to further the education of women. Over these many years, we have gathered statistical information on the number of women served, institutions they attend, majors and course of study, as well as demographic and residential information. We can point to multiple women representing professionals in medicine, nursing, healthcare, business, government and social services, education, engineering, science, entrepreneurship and so much more.

Application/Selection Process

Nevada Women's Fund Allocations Committee is comprised of 15 dedicated members including NWF Board representatives and esteemed community members, who meticulously review and evaluate each eligible application received. After careful consideration, the highest-scoring applicants are thoughtfully matched with the most suitable scholarship donor(s). Scholarships ranging from \$2,000 to \$5,000 are awarded each Spring.



Communication, Monitoring, Evaluation

Donors are extended the opportunity to personally meet their individual scholarship recipient(s), to hear firsthand the inspiring stories of the remarkable women whose lives have been positively impacted by their generosity. Nevada Women's Fund actively collects data from both current and past scholarship recipients to assess programmatic success and ensure donor satisfaction.

Two Funding Options:





Annual Scholarship

Funded annually prior to March 1st and awarded each April

Scholarships range from \$2,000 -\$5,000 with an average of \$3,600

\$2,000 + Annually

Endowed Scholarship

Gradually build your endowment to the fundable amount within a span of five years, with flexibility to add additional funds at any given time.

4.5% of the endowments value is withdrawn and distributed in scholarships each spring in perpetuity.
